

RESOLUTION 2015-13

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF THE SAN BENITO COUNTY WATER DISTRICT
TO APPROVE A PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the SAN BENITO COUNTY WATER DISTRICT ("District") is vested with the power to do any and every lawful act necessary so that sufficient water may be available for any present or future beneficial use or uses on the lands or for the inhabitants within the District including the storage and distribution of water for domestic, fire protection and municipal uses; and

WHEREAS, the District is further vested with the power to acquire by grant or otherwise, and to hold, use and enjoy real and personal property of every kind including land, structures, and buildings, and to alter and operate any and all works or improvements necessary to carry out the purposes of the District; and

WHEREAS, Section 70-15 of California Water Code Appendix (District Act) authorizes the District to institute projects in a Zone of Benefit for the financing, construction, operation and maintenance of any work of improvement of common benefit to such Zone; and

WHEREAS, the District intends to initiate Phase I of the Recycled Water Facilities project within Zone 6 by establishing service boundaries and commencing construction of the recycled water pipeline system to serve properties within the service area; and

WHEREAS, the recycled water project is a benefit to Zone 6 in that the use of recycled water by landowners in the service area serves to preserve groundwater and San Felipe water supplies for the benefit of other users in Zone 6; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors held a public hearing on May 27, 2015 at 6:00 p.m. in the District office, 30 Mansfield Road, Hollister, California, for the purpose of approving the Recycled Water Facilities project; and

WHEREAS, there were no written protests against the proposed project, signed by a majority in number of the electors in Zone 6.

An “elector” for purposes of this paragraph shall mean any person, who is qualified to vote in the State of California, is registered under the provisions of the California Elections Code in the precinct of the proposed zone and is a resident of the proposed zone as of the date of the aforementioned public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED:

by the Board of Directors of the San Benito County Water District that this Resolution No. 2015-13 hereby approves the Recycled Water Facilities project and authorizes it to proceed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the President of the Board is authorized to sign said Resolution, on behalf of this Board and District.

This resolution shall be in effect retroactively to April 1, 2015.
